SUMMARY: The Props Manager is responsible for the realization of all prop elements and may include "outside" non-FRP projects.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work with PM to hire all props staff
- With PM develop and oversee annual/show budgets
- Oversee Load-In and Strike of props
- Long range planning to serve equipment and facility needs of prop shop
- Oversee and coordinate the creation, construction and procurement of all props- consult with TD on construction of props as necessary/appropriate
- Create cost estimates on shows prior to build
- Work directly with designers and directors to establish priorities
- Attend all technical rehearsals and production meetings
- Maintain clean and safe workspaces
- Maintain all shop inventory and equipment
- Working knowledge of prop stock/inventory and storage facilities
- Provide support for Playhouse Jr classes, camps, outreach and other playhouse events
- Develop and deliver curriculum to Playhouse Jr campers as well as entry level technicians
- Assist with parking shifts pre-show, ensuring an efficient traffic flow, and a safe organized experience for guests

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Bachelor Degree in related field preferred.
- Required: High school diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum 3-5 years experience in Props for the Theatre

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED:

- Supervisory skills
- Ability to work within tight deadlines and budgets
